Follow Houston Levee Rd. **east** (turn **left** from Houston High) to Raleigh LaGrange, turn **right**. Continue 1.5 mi. to Bethany Rd., turn **right**. At fork, take Shady Lane to **left**. Past Shady Hollow Cv. on the **right**, look for gravel driveway with sign at top of drive; follow drive past house to the barn.

From Cordova:

Follow Walnut Grove **east** from Germantown Rd. all the way to dead end. Turn **right** onto Raleigh LaGrange. About 2.5 mi. to Bethany Rd., turn **right**. At fork, take Shady Lane to **left**. Past Shady Hollow Cv. on the **right**, look for gravel driveway with sign at top of drive, follow drive past house to the barn.

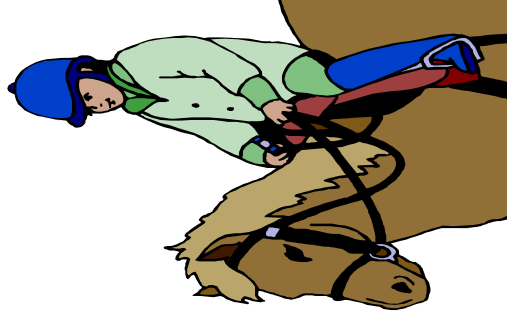
